

I, John England, Supervisor of Registration of Electors, of said County do hereby certify that the County canvassing Board consisting of Rogelio Gomez County Judge, John England Supervisor of Registration of Electors, and Carl Bervaldi Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of said County, constituting the Board of County Canvassers in and for the County of Monroe, State of Florida, met in the office of the Supervisor of Registration at the County Court House, Key West, Florida, at two thirty O'clock P.M. on June 5th, 1936, whereupon Mr. Bervaldi brought to the attention of the Canvassing Board the fact that there were no complete returns from the several voting precincts, of Monroe County, Florida, by reason of the temporary restraining order entered by Judge Jefferson B. Brown of the Circuit Court of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida on June 2nd, 1936, which restraining order was not dissolved until June 5th, 1936. Mr. Bervaldi then moved that the Board adjourn from day to day until said returns should be complete. on the afternoon of June 5th, A.D. 1936, it was decided by the Board of County Commissioners to recall the Clerks and Inspectors of the Precincts involved in the above order, and under the supervision of the County Canvassing Board have the ballots that were held up by the above order counted at the Court house, which decision was carried out. and at Seven O'clock P.M. on June 5th, A.D. 1936, the Canvassing Board met on the second floor of the Court House, and proceeded publicly to canvass the votes given for the several offices and persons hereinafter specified at the Democratic Primary Election held in said County on the 2nd, day of June A.D. 1936, as shown by the returns on file in the office of the County Judge and the Supervisor of Registration respectively, and we do hereby certify solely, exclusively and entirely from said returns that the whole of votes cast.
