I, John England, Supervisor of Registration of Electors, of said County do hereby certify that the County canvassing Board consisting of Raymond R. Lord, County Judge, John England Supervisor of Registration, and Carl Bervaldi Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, of said County, Constituting the Board of County Canvassers in and for the said County, met in the office of the Supervisor of Registration of Electors aforesaid, on the Sixth day of November, A.D. 1936, and proceeded publicly to canvass the votes given for the several offices and persons herein-after specified at the General Election held in said County on the 3rd, Day of November A.D. 1936, as shown by the returns on file in the office of said Judge and Supervisor of Registration of Electors, respectively.

At Two o'clock P.M. on the above date the Board was called to order by the Chairmand, the Hon. Raymond R. Lord County Judge, at which time the County Attorney advised the Board of Canvassers that Mr. J. R. Combs of Tavernier, Florida, who was present wished to make a statement to the Board relative to his defeat for Constable of the third District, by Cleveland Johnson, an independant Candidate, he claimed that Mr. Johnson had been given credit for votes that was not properly spelled, But as the canvassing Board had no power to handle matters of this kind, and had to be governed by Sec. 343. (287) General Election Laws of Florida, It was moved and Seconded that Mr. Cleveland Johnson be declared Elected as shown by the returns on file with the County Judge and the Supervisor of Registration, same was carried on a vote of the Board, Mr. Combs was advised that he could take what ever action he saw fit in the matter with the proper authority.
