(Providing manner of electing State Atorneys, Judges and Solicitors Criminal Courts of Record, setting forth length of term and manner of filling vacancies.)

To Amend Article V of the Constitution of the State of Florida by adding an Additional Section to be known as Section 47, Relating to the Election of State Attorneys, Judges and Solicitors Criminal Courts of Record (except Judges and Solicitors Court of Record Escambia County) and providing for the manner of filling vacancies in such offices prior to 1st Tuesday after 1st Monday in January, 1949, by appointment by the Governor and Confirmation by Senate.
