I, Samuel B. Pinder, Sr., Supervisor of Registration of Electors, of said County do hereby certify that the County Canvassing Board consisting of Raymond R. Lord, County Judge; Gerald Saunders, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners; and Samuel B. Pinder, Sr., Supervisor of Registration of said County, met in the office of the Supervisor of Registration aforesaid on the 5th day of May, A.D. 1954, at 10:00 A.M. and proceeded publicly to canvass the vote given for the several offices and persons, together with the absentee ballots submitted, as hereinafter specified, at the first primary election held in said County on the 4th day of May, A.D. 1954, as shown by the returns on file in the office of said Judge and Supervisor of Registration, respectively, and we hereby certify solely and entirely from said returns as follows: The total number of votes cast was Seven thousand four hundred and three (7,403); the total number of Electors qualified was Ten thousand two hundred and seven (10,207)


