HELD ON MAY 29, 1956

I, Samuel B. Pinder, Sr., Supervisor of Registration of Electors, of said County do hereby certify that the County Canvassing Board consisting of Raymond R. Lord, County Judge; Gerald Saunders, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners; and Samuel B. Pinder, Sr., Supervisor of Registration of said County, met in the County Commissioner's Chambers on the 30th day of May, A.D. 1956 at 10:00 A.M. and proceeded publicly to canvass the vote given for the offices and persons, together with the absentee ballots (356 ballots were mailed and voted in person - 11 of these absentee ballots were opened in error by the County Judge and counted), as hereinafter specified, at the second primary election held in said County on the 29th day of May, A.D. 1956, as shown by the returns on file in the office of said Judge and Supervisor of Registration, respectively, and we hereby certify solely and entirely from said returns as follows: The total number of votes cast were Six thousand nine hundred & seventy-three (6,973); the total number of Electors qualified were Twelve thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight (12,988)

For the nomination of a Democratic candidate for Member House of Representatives, Group No. 2, the whole number of votes cast was Six thousand nine hundred & thirty-eight, (6,938)


