BILLY FREEMAN, Supervisor of Elections, and DON SCHLOESSER, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, constituting the Board of County Canvassers in and for said County, do hereby certify that we met in the office of the Supervisor of Elections on the 7th day of February, A. D., 1979, and proceeded to publicly canvass the votes given in the REFERENDUM ELECTION held on the 6th day of February, A. D., 1979, as shown by the returns on file in the office of the County Judge and Supervisor of Elections respectively. We do hereby certify from said returns as follows:

PROPOSAL

SHOULD THE FLORIDA KEYS AQUEDUCT AUTHORITY BUILD A NEW PIPELINE AND NEW WATER TREATMENT FACILITIES BY ACCEPTING A LOAN OF \$53,225,000.00 FROM FARMER'S HOME ADMINISTRATION, AT 5% AMORTIZED OVER 40 YEARS, EVIDENCED BY REVENUE BONDS TO FARMER'S HOME ADMINISTRATION?
