

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A NON-BINDING REFERENDUM DECLARING WHETHER THE KEY WEST CITY COMMISSION SHOULD AUTHORIZE EXPENDITURE OF UP TO 1.5 PERCENT OF THE CITY'S ANNUAL OPERATING BUDGET, OR UP TO \$150,000, WHICHEVER IS LESS, IN SUPPORT OF NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS SERVING KEY WEST; AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO TAKE ACTION NECESSARY TO PLACE THIS MEASURE ON THE BALLOT FOR THE OCTOBER 6, 1987 PRIMARY ELECTION AND TO PROVIDE NOTICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. A non-binding referendum shall be held on October 6, 1987, in Key West, Monroe County, Florida. The question appearing on the ballot shall be titled "Non-Binding Referendum--City Budget Support of Non-Profit Organizations Serving Key West." The question shall be worded substantially as follows:


"Shall the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, Authorize Expenditure of Up To 1.5% of the City's Annual Operating Budget, Or Up To \$150,000.00, Whichever Is Less, In Support of Non-Profit Organizations Serving Key West?"


Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary and proper action to place the above question on the ballot and to provide notice of the election in accordance with law.

Section 3. This Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
