

## **Notice:** A felon must have clemency to run for office.

November 2018: Constitutional Amendment, Article VI, Section 4 Voting Restoration

This amendment <u>restores the voting rights</u> of Floridians with felony convictions after they complete all terms of their sentence including parole or probation. The amendment would not apply to those convicted of murder or sexual offenses, who would continue to be permanently barred from voting unless the Governor and Cabinet vote to restore their voting rights on a case by case basis.

The 2018 Amendment 4 <u>addresses only the restoration of voting rights.</u> A felon must get clemency to run for office.
