Please remember that only the signer of the petition may sign and date the petition. Any information left off a petition by the signer (other than signature and date) may be filled in by another person.

If a petition is turned in without required information it will be entered as an error and that signer <u>may not sign</u> another petition for that candidate.

If a candidate is running in a NONpartisan race it is recommended that the candidate put "xxxxxxx" on the line for the candidate political party.

Many candidates will have a printer prefill their names, party, and office sought. They will also have highlighted the areas for the voter to sign.

Please bring in petitions in small groups as you get them so that we can keep you updated on the amount of accepted petitions you have collected. There will be rejected petitions.
